

Neighborhood Information Meetings

You are invited to attend the **Russell Square Residential Planned Unit Development (RPUD)** by Neal Communities of Southwest Florida LLC Neighborhood Information Meeting (NIM) to be held on Thursday, May 10, 2018 at 5:30pm at Shepherd of the Glades Lutheran Church, Fellowship Hall, 6020 Rattlesnake Hammock Rd.

The subject property is comprised of approximately 32.9+/- acres, located on the east side of Santa Barbara Blvd, approximately 1/4 miles south of Davis Blvd.

The petitioner is requesting to rezone approximately ±32.9-acres from "A," Agriculture (ST Overlay) Zoning District to a Residential Planned Unit Development (RPUD) Zoning District to allow for a maximum of 230 multi-family residential dwelling units. Access to the site is from proposed Cope Lane. Residential amenities will be provided

on-site for use by residents of the RPUD.

The property is 4.5 acres, and it has one story, 4,800 SF building, a playground for kids, 5 bathrooms, a kitchen, 8 rooms and a swimming pool.
