business Grimm's Stone Crab, Inc, which was established in 2003.

Howie has been an active member of the Everglades City Government since 1995, when he was appointed to the Everglades City's Citizens Advisory Task Force (CATF) Committee for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funding. He served over 6 years as a committee member on the Everglades City Planning and Zoning Committee. In 2013, he was elected to be a Everglades City Council Member. On September 5, 2015, Howie was selected by council to serve as Pro Tem Mayor and was formally elected by the citizens of Everglades City as the Mayor of the city on November 28, 2017.

## Solar Purchasing Power

Solar United Neighbors of Florida, a solar Co-op has launched in Collier County to make going green more affordable for residents and small businesses. It's free to join the co-op and there's no requirement to buy or install solar power. Members will have more purchasing power as a group, allowing them to get a price break, and in 2019 there is a 30% federal tax credit.

When at least 30 members sign up, the co-op will solicit proposals for competitive bids to find an installer, who will work with homeowners or business owners individually on projects.
