

**MEETING MINUTES**  
**EAST NAPLES CIVIC ASSOCIATION**  
**June 6, 2018 @ 5:30pm**

**1. Call to Order**

President Shirley Calhoun called the meeting to order at 5:35pm.

*Attending were:*

Tom Cannon, Neil Curley, George Danz, Donna Fiala, Jean Kungle, Jeff Mascasevich, Jim Pusateri, Christopher Shucart, Jacob Winge, and guests Sue Orshell and Bernie Harris.

Approval of Minutes May 2018, Jim Pusateri motioned to accept, Neil Curley 2nd, passed all in favor.

**2. Treasurer's Report** – Motion to accept Jim Pusateri, Jeff Mascasevich 2nd, passed all in favor.

**3. East Naples Foundation** - Charity Golf Tournament brought in just over \$8,000 with \$4,000 going to high school seniors scholarships, \$2,000 to Lorenzo Walker Technical for student certifications, tools, etc., and \$2,000 to Parkside Elementary Reading Program.

**4. Reports of Chairs**

*Development* - The craft brewery on Bayshore is planning an October 2018 opening. A developer/builder purchased Cirrus Pointe and wants to build 1,800-2,000sf condos with garages for professionals. It was noted Commissioner Taylor is fighting for low income units on the CAPA 17 acre site and Cirrus Pointe but is getting a lot of resistance as Bayshore CRA has been working hard to clean up the blight in that area and needs more moderate not low income. Habitat wants to expand Regal Acres community on Greenway Rd with 11 acres owned and an option on 12 acres. The Affordable Housing Department at June 26 BCC meeting will try to pass buy/right on low income projects which means land would not be vetted for zoning changes through the normal county channels but staff could sign off on it; it was noted too many consequences for the future and unknowns. Trio project has been sold to Bill Higgs. Sue Orshell noted the county has \$2.5 million HUD grant funds and she heard Habitat will be getting the majority and will look into it. Will also reach out to GG Civic and see about partnering on some issues.

**5. Open Business**

*June Sunset Cruise* - 35 signed up so far. June 1st opens to non-members.

*July Luncheon* - Inviting the county commissioners running for office for a Q&A. Will find a moderator.

*East Naples Merchant's Website Ad* - Membership ad complete and running this summer

*Membership Envelopes* - Will redesign and print like the old ones with the envelope in white rather than green to make it easier than the one page application for sending in.
