## ShadowWood Planned Unit Development on Planning Commission Agenda

An Ordinance of the Board of County Commissioners of Collier County, Florida amending Ordinance Number 82-49, as amended, the ShadowWood Planned Unit Development (PUD), to redesignate 4± acres of land from Tract C, private air park district, to Tract E, residential development; by adding the development standards for Tract E; by amending the master plan to add 3 access points to provide ingress and egress to Tract E including access to Polly Avenue, Atkins Road and Whitaker Road; by removing a requirement that all access roads to the PUD are private roads; and by revising developer commitments. The subject property consisting of 77.99± acres is part of the 168.1 acre PUD located at Wing South Air Park, east of Santa Barbara Boulevard between Davis Boulevard and Rattlesnake-Hammock Road, in Section 16, Township 50 South, Range 26 East, Collier County, Florida.

## Downpayment Assistance Application Time Is Here

If you know of someone needing downpayment assistance for the purchase of their own home or condo, this is the time of year to apply to the county for some extra help while funds are available. Please help get the word out.

The Collier County Community and Human Services Division (CHS) is pleased to announce the opening of the FY 2020-2021 grant application cycle.

This year's grant application cycle will be for Local, State, and Federal grant funds.

Collier County anticipates receiving federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the following programs:

Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in the estimated amount of \$2,000,000.

HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) in the estimated amount of \$800,000.

Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) in the estimated amount of \$200,000.

CHS will also be accepting grant applications for State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP) funding of approximately \$700,000 in this application cycle.

There is also approximately \$150,000 of Local Housing Trust Funds available for application.

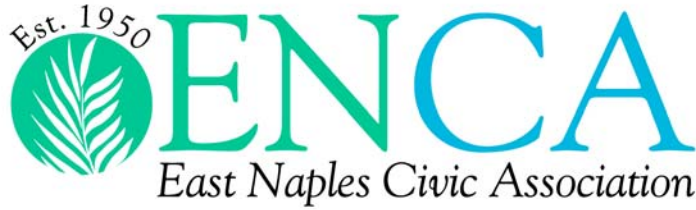
