

## **East Naples Community Development Plan Update**

The county interviewed the top three scoring consulting companies on June 10 & 13, 2019 at the County Procurement Department.

The three companies interviewed were Canin Associates, Dix-Hite, and Tindale-Oliver. Tindale-Oliver was awarded the task to develop the East Naples Community Development Plan.

Now that the consulting firm has been chosen from the group, a budget for the project will be presented to Commissioners to approve in September...then the real work will begin.

ENCA members and residents of our communities will be asked to participate in the process and committees will be formed.

## **Flamingo Estates and the Coconut Circle Clean-Up**

On Saturday, June 08, 2019, the North Naples and East Naples Code Enforcement Districts teamed up with the Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Division, East Naples Civic Association, Collier County Sheriff's Office, and Waste Management Inc. to host a neighbor-



hood cleanup for residents of Flamingo Estates and the Coconut Circle areas. Nearly 7,000lbs of trash, litter, waste, and

debris were loaded into dumpsters and removed from the neighborhood. Of that weight, nearly 1,700 lbs of Household Hazardous Materials were collected.

Barry Williams joined the county in June 2001 and has served as the Parks and Recreation Director since 2006. In his position he oversees planning, budget, and operations of 69 parks in Collier County. The Parks & Recreation department has 220 full-time employees, 150 seasonal employees, and 125 contracted instructors. He manages the development of park lands, maintenance of parks, oversight of recreational programming, and maintenance of preserved lands. Barry has a budget responsibility of \$52M with capital expenditures of \$10M.
