There is a Shadowood Planned Unit Development Insubstantial Change Neighborhood Information Meeting (NIM) scheduled for Tuesday, May 7, 2019 from 5:30pm-7:30pm at the Mayflower Congregational Church, 2900 County Barn Road.

Shadowood is located off Rattlesnake Hammock Rd. across from Grand Lely Dr. and includes the ShadowWood Villas and Wing South Airpark.

East Naples Community Development Plan Update

Interviews with four of the six consultant companies that submitted proposals for the RFP (Request For Proposal) to develop the East Naples Community Development Plan will be held June 4th with County staff from the Procurement Department at 2:00pm in their office. Once the consulting firm is chosen from the group, a budget will be presented, Commissioners will have to approve, and then the work will begin.

ENCA members and residents of our communities will be able to participate in the process and a committee will be formed.

Jolley Bridge Is Now Lit Up

After damage from Hurricane Irma and waiting a year and seven long months, the lights on the Jolley Bridge are now repaired and lit up! Travel safe!

Ankrolab Now Open! And Bayshore CRA Update...

The Ankrolab Brewery has finally opened! Additional parking available on the empty lot at Bayshore and Coco.

The lot at Bayshore and Coco, owned by the CRA, is planned to be paved and landscaped. It would include 37 spaces, bike racks, 2 electric chargers and a curbside pickup for Uber type services, if approved.

The parking lot on Becca, across from the Celebration Food Truck Park, and owned by Rebecca Maddox, is also planned for paving, landscaping and lighting.

The 17 Acre Property is still under consideration. At this time two proposals have been introduced: 1) In order to focus on the original intended arts district theme, and in line with citizen survey results, a cultural performing and visual Arts Center, with 500-600 seat theater, galleries, studios, and parking facility is proposed, all with connection to Sugden Park. And 2)

Demolition & Construction Has Begun

Demolition began last week at the corner of Shadowlawn and US41 for the new RaceTrac to be built there.

At the corner of Rattlesnake and US41, demolition began in the shopping plaza for the future WaWa. They will be demolishing only a section of the plaza.

Construction of the new WaWa at the new Price Street Plaza at the corner of Price St. and US41 has also commenced. The Dollar Tree and Tire Kingdom are now open for business.
